### 1. RECOMMENDATION

Waste licence Reg. No. W0223-01 has ceased to have effect as the carrying on of the activity to which the licence relates did not substantially commence within a period of five years beginning on the date on which the licence was granted on 02/11/2007 and subsequent extension of three years. I recommend that:

- Fingal County Council's Planning and Environment Sections are notified that Kilshane Cross Recycling Park licence has ceased to have effect from 02/11/2015 and the activity cannot now commence under this licence.

### 3. FACILITY LOCATION AND HISTORY

The site is located approximately 1.5km north of the N2/M50 interchange, in the townland of Newtown, Kilshane Cross, Dublin 15. Kilshane Cross Recycling Park (the licensee) was granted waste licence Reg. No. W0223-01 on 02/11/2007 to carryout non-hazardous waste activities. The site which was agricultural land was proposed to consist of the following:

- (a) A Construction and Demolition (C&D) Waste Recovery Unit processing 75,000 tonnes per annum (tpa);
- (b) A Waste Transfer Unit (WT) dealing with 65,000 tpa of municipal solid waste;
- (c) A Biological Waste Treatment Unit (BWT) treating 45,000 tpa of separately collected domestic and commercial organic waste, and
- (d) A Sludge Hub Centre (SHC) treating 26,511 tpa of dewatered sludge cake waste from wastewater treatment facilities in Fingal County Council's functional area.

Currently, the site is secured by a locked gate with fencing surrounding the site. The infrastructure as listed above was not developed. There are internal roads and an office on site.

#### 4. AGENCY'S ASSESSMENT

---

Based on a site visit to Kilshane Cross Recycling Park on the 10/12/2015 it was determined that the activity for which the facility was licensed did not substantially commence within a period of five years (Ref. Technical Amendment A to waste licence W0223-01) and subsequent extension of three years (Ref. MM02NH.docx). The site was observed to be closed and the activity to which the waste licence relates has not been substantially commenced.


