Introduction

A Waste Water Discharge Licence was first granted for the Smithborough agglomeration by the Environmental Protection Agency on the 20th June 2013. Reg No. D0464-01.

Reason for Clerical Amendment

The reason for the Clerical Amendment is to correct typographical errors that occurred in the final licence document. Amend text in *Schedule A.2: Secondary Waste Water Discharge(s) & Monitoring* as follows: in *Discharges -* column 3, change Interim % Reduction to Interim ELV and in *Discharges -* column 4, change % Reduction to ELV.

Recommendation

I recommend that the licence amendment be approved as set out in the attached recommended Clerical Amendment. Such an amendment does not result in the relevant requirements of Regulation 6(3) of the *Waste Water Discharge* (Authorisation) Regulations 2007, (as amended) ceasing to be satisfied.
