Notice under Section 92(3) of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992, as amended

Dear Ms Corcoran,

The Agency refers to Industrial Emissions Licence W0161-02 held by Cork County Council.

You are advised that:

1. In accordance with Section 92(3) of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992, as amended, Industrial Emissions Licence W0161-02 has ceased to have effect as of 6/01/2014.
2. The licensable activity cannot recommence under this licence and would require a new licence application to do so.
3. While any current processes/activities being carried out on-site are not relevant to the licence issued by the Agency, the provisions of Section 92(4) of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992, as amended, will continue to apply until such time as a surrender application is made and granted for this licence.
4. Any new activity at the site is outside the remit of the Industrial Emissions licence, and may come under the requirements of environmental legislation in this regard and/or require a single media licence.
5. Section 86B of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992, as amended, may be relevant to the Industrial Emissions Licence W0161-02. Please revert to the Agency with confirmation as to whether any hazardous substances have been used, produced or released at the site due to the carrying out of an industrial emissions directive activity, that may require actions to be taken under subsection (6), (7) or (8) of Section 86B of the Act.

Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992, as amended

92.

(3) Where the activity to which a licence or revised licence relates ceases to be carried on then, unless the activity is resumed within the period of 3 years beginning on the date of that cessation, the licence shall cease to have effect on the expiry of the said period.

(4) The cesser of a licence's or a revised licence's effect under this section shall in no way affect or diminish such conditions, requirements or obligations applying to or falling on the licensee as are specified in or arise under the licence.
