Dear Ms Loughlin,

As you are aware the European Union (Industrial Emissions) Regulations 2013 made a number of amendments to the provisions of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992 as amended and the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended, for the purposes of giving effect to the requirements of Directive 2010/75/EU (Industrial Emissions Directive).

In this regard the provisions of these Acts have been amended to include a requirement that the Agency examine all licences granted. The purpose of the examination is to establish if licences, in respect of activities listed in Annex I to the Industrial Emissions Directive, comply with the requirements of that Directive.

Having confirmed that your licence, Reg. No. W0180-01, was in force on the coming into operation of this amendment, and in accordance with Section 76A(10) of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended, the Agency consulted with McGill Environmental Systems (Ireland) Limited W0180-01 in 2013 through EDEN; through subsequent EPA correspondence dated 05/08/2015; and telephone calls on 21/08/2015 and 26/08/2015. The Agency has examined correspondence submitted by you through EDEN dated 30/07/2013, and more recently your response received by telephone on 26/08/2015.

In accordance with Section 76A(9)(a) of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended, the Agency has examined the terms of the licence as amended, granted to McGill Environmental Systems (Ireland) Limited on 17/02/2004 in respect of the facility located at Coom, Carrignavar/Glenville, Cork, County Cork; and the information provided by you in the correspondence detailed above, for the purposes of determining if the licence is required to be

amended to bring it into conformity with the Industrial Emissions Directive as provided for in the legislation.

Having completed its examination, the Agency has determined that your licence Reg. No. W0180-01 does not relate to an Industrial Emissions Directive activity as defined in the Environmental Protection Agency Acts 1992, as amended. Hence, your licence, Reg. No. W0180-01 does not relate to an Industrial Emissions Directive activity as defined in the Environmental Protection Agency Acts 1992, as amended, and thus, will remain as a Waste Licence. Accordingly no further action is required to bring the licence into conformity with the IE Directive.

This notice is for the purposes of Section 76A(9)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended only, and nothing in this notification shall be construed as negating the licensee's statutory obligations or requirement under this Act.
