A copy of the EIAR has been submitted to Offaly County Council as part of an application for planning permission for the proposed development. A copy of the application for the licence may be inspected on the Agency's website or inspected at or obtained from the Headquarters of the Agency as soon as is practicable after the receipt by the Agency of the application for the licence.

APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE REVIEW OF A LICENCE Advanced Environmental Solutions (Ireland) Limited is applying to the Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) for a review of the Industrial Emissions Licence for its Materials Recovery Facility located at Cappanour, Tullamore, County Offaly.
