The Directors considered a recommendation from the Office of Environmental Sustainability that the Agency approve the Recommended Decision to grant a Waste Licence. The following documentation was submitted: Recommended Decision and Report of the Inspector dated 24 July 2017.

Inspector’s Report

The Directors noted the Inspector’s Report.

Recommended Decision

Introduction

Delete the wording ‘inert’ in the first sentence of the first paragraph to read as follows: ‘This waste licence relates to the operation of an ~~inert~~ waste recovery facility at Huntstown Quarry, Huntstown, Kilshane and Johnstown Townlands, Finglas, Dublin 11, by Roadstone Limited.’

Conditions

12.2.3 Amend the condition to read as follows: “The licensee shall, prior to commencement of the *new C&D waste recovery* and to the satisfaction of the Agency, make a *revised* financial provision to cover any *new* liabilities associated with the operation (including closure, restoration and aftercare). The amount of financial provision held shall be reviewed and revised as necessary, but at least annually. Proof of renewal or revision of such financial indemnity shall be included in the annual ‘Statement of Measures’ report identified in Condition 12.2.1.’

Conditions

3.10.2 Amend the condition to read as follows: “All stockpiles shall be adequately *covered* and managed to minimise dust generation and rainwater infiltration.’

3.10.3 Amend the condition to read as follows: “In dry weather ~~waste~~ stockpiles stored outdoors shall be sprayed with water.’

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Roadstone Limited, for their facility at Huntstown Quarry, Huntstown, Kilshane and Johnstown, Townlands, Finglas, Dublin 11, Register of Licence No W0277-03, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
