The EIAR was downloaded from the EPA website and read. This office is concerned primarily with highlighting issues of public health and environmental concerns. This office has received no environmental complaints in relation to the past or present operation of this facility.

All commitments to future actions including mitigation and further testing have been taken as read and all data results have been accepted as accurate. No additional investigations / measurements were undertaken.

In relation to these types of developments the areas of concern from an environmental health perspective are soils and geology, water, air, noise and material assets. These areas of concern are addressed in the EIAR downloaded from the EPA website.
