TECHNICAL AMENDMENT D
TO
WASTE LICENCE

Licence Register Number:	W0034-02
Licensee:	Dundalk Town Council
Location of Facility:	Dundalk Landfill and Civic Waste Facility Newry Road Dundalk County Louth

Reasons for the Decision

The Environmental Protection Agency is satisfied, on the basis of the information available, that subject to compliance with the conditions of Licence Register Number W0034-02 granted on 23 March 2005 and amended on 9 August 2005, 20 October 2005 and 15 January 2013 as well as any amendments noted herein, any emissions from the activity will comply with and not contravene any of the requirements of Section 40(4) of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended.

A screening for Appropriate Assessment was undertaken to assess, in view of best scientific knowledge and the conservation objectives of the site, if the activity, individually or in combination with other plans or projects is likely to have a significant effect on any European site. In this context, particular attention was paid to the European sites at Dundalk Bay SAC [000455] and Dundalk Bay SPA [004026].

The activity is not directly connected with or necessary to the management of any European site and the Agency considered, for the reasons set out below, that it can be excluded, on the basis of objective information, that the activity, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, will have a significant effect on any European site and accordingly determined that an Appropriate Assessment of the activity was not required.

Reasons: The volume of discharge to foul sewer is low and the concentration of pollutants in the discharge is relatively low. The discharge from the downstream Dundalk waste water treatment plant is regulated by Licence Register Number D0053-01 and the potential effect of heavy metals in the discharge is regulated by that licence.

Technical Amendment

In pursuance of the powers conferred on it by Section 42B(1)(c) of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended, the Agency amends licence register number W0034-02 granted to Dundalk Town Council on 23 March 2005.

Henceforth, the licence shall be read in conjunction with Amendment A issued on 9 August 2005, Amendment B issued on 20 October 2005, Amendment C issued on 15 January 2013 and the amendments set out below.

This technical amendment is limited to the following:

- Condition 6.7.

Amendments

Conditions of the licence

6.7.8 Leachate and run-off may be discharged to Irish Water sewer at manhole F1 shown on Drawing No. IBR0785/03, Site Drainage Proposal, provided with Licence Change Request CR03343. The discharge and discharge point shall be subject generally to the conditions of this licence and, in particular, to:

- limit values set out in Schedule C.4,
- monitoring frequencies set out in Table D.7.1 of Schedule D.7, and
- interpretation of data as described in Condition 6.8.

Samples taken at F1 shall also be analysed for heavy metals.

To be inserted after Condition 6.7.7 of the existing licence

This technical amendment shall be cited as Amendment D (in pursuance of Section 42B(1) of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended) to Waste Licence Register Number W0034-02.
