<p>The Agency granted an Industrial Emissions licence subject to conditions, on 24/10/2018 to Mr Declan Sullivan, Reg. No. P1065-01, for Class 6.1: the rearing of poultry in installations where the capacity exceeds 40,000 places, located at Drumcreeghan, Latton, Castleblaney, County Monaghan.</p>
