RE: Application for a Review of a Licence – Advanced Environmental Solutions (Ireland), Notice under Section 87(1)(a) of the Act of 1992

Dear Sir / Madam,

Advanced Environmental Services (Ireland) Limited is applying to the Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) for a review of the Waste Licence for its Materials Recovery Facility located at Springfort Cross, Solsborough, Nenagh, County Tipperary.

It is proposed to increase the amount of non-hazardous waste accepted at the installation from 24,750 tonnes to 30,000 tonnes annually. There will be no change to the types of waste accepted. The class and nature of the industrial emissions directive activity in accordance with the First Schedule to the Act of 1992, as amended are:

**11.1 The recovery or disposal of waste in a facility, within the meaning of the Act of 1996, which facility is connected or associated with another activity specified in this Schedule in respect of which a licence or revised licence under Part IV is in force or in respect of which a licence under the said Part is or will be required.**

An Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) will be submitted to the Agency with the application. The EIAR and any further information relating to the effects on the environment of the emissions from the activity, which may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application, will be available at the headquarters of the Agency.

A copy of the EIAR was submitted to the Council as part of an application for planning permission for the proposed development. A copy of the application for the licence may be inspected on the Agency's website or inspected at or obtained from the Headquarters of the Agency as soon as is practicable after the receipt by the Agency of the application for the licence.
