

APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE REVIEW OF A WASTE LICENCE

Advanced Environmental Solutions (Ireland) Limited is applying to the Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) for a review of the Waste Licence for its Materials Recovery Facility located at Solsborough, Nenagh, County Tipperary.

It is proposed to increase the amount of non-hazardous waste accepted at the facility from 24,750 tonnes to 30,000 tonnes annually. There will be no change to the types of waste accepted.

The class of activity in accordance with the Third and Fourth Schedules of the Waste Management Act 1996, as amended will be to the Act of 1992, as amended are:

D13 Blending or mixing prior to submission to any of the operations numbered from D 1 to 12 (if there is no other D code appropriate, this can include preliminary operations prior to disposal including pre-processing such as, amongst others, sorting, crushing, compacting, pelletising, drying, shredding, conditioning or separating prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D12)

R12 Exchange of waste for submission to any of the operations numbered R 1 to R 11 (if there is no other R code appropriate, this can include preliminary operations prior to recovery including pre-processing such as, amongst others, dismantling, sorting, crushing, compacting, pelletising, drying, shredding, conditioning, repackaging, separating, blending or mixing prior to submission to any of the operations numbered R1 to R11)

Class R12 will be the principal activity.

An Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) will be submitted to the Agency with the application. A copy of the application, the EIAR and such further information relating to the application as may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application, will, as soon as is practicable after receipt by the Agency, be available for inspection or purchase at the headquarters of the Agency.
