RE: Grenagh Wastewater Discharge Licence Application D0544-01

Dear Breen,

Irish Water wishes to submit the following unsolicited correspondence for the Grenagh WWDL application.

Irish Water are requesting the withdrawal of the wastewater discharge licence application D0544-01. The reason for this, is that Irish Water intend to further refine the Interim Load Methodology (ITM) for population equivalent (P.E.) estimation, to take account of commuter effects and realistic commercial usage in small settlements.

A recent review of the agglomeration P.E. for Grenagh, taking into account the above, estimated it to be 467.

Accordingly, Irish Water requests the wastewater discharge licence application D0544-01 be withdrawn due to the revised P.E.. The Certificate of Authorisation (A0524-01) will therefore remain in place.
