- There will be no significant emissions to air from the facility.
- The only emissions from the facility will be the discharges of storm water into River Delvin and River Fourknocks which ultimately discharge into a coastal waterbody, 9km downstream of the facility. The Water Framework Directive (WFD) status of this coastal waterbody is good.

- The nearest European Site, River Nanny Estuary and Shore SPA (Site Code: 004158), is located 10 km downstream of the facility, in this coastal waterbody.
