Mr. William Murphy, Gillardstown House, Castlepollard, Co. Westmeath submitted a licence application under Class 6.2 of the First Schedule of the EPA Acts 1992 to 2007, to rear pigs in an installation where the capacity exceeds 2000 places for production pigs in an installation, at Deerpark, Castlepollard, Co. Westmeath. The applicant submitted an IPPC Application Form and also separate correspondence which the applicant has requested be held as confidential information and returned once assessed.

The information submitted in a confidential format relates to the pig slurry landspreading capacity on customer farms and the suitability of these lands for this purpose.

The confidential information comprises of a declaration by a suitably qualified person that the lands have been inspected and are suitable for the receipt of organic fertilizers. It also comprises details of the customer farms namely farm name, farm code, townlands on which landspreading occurs, available land area (ha), maximum slurry import volume (m³) and maximum phosphorus intake (Kg P).

The applicant includes as part of the IPPC Application Form (i.e. in non-confidential format) summary details of slurry generation at the installation, maps showing the approximate location of the coded customer farms, summary table with the farm customer code, townlands, manure requirement for each farm.

Recommendation

The information marked "Confidential" is essential for the processing of the application, however; it is not considered necessary for the Agency to retain the confidential information submitted.

The information marked "Confidential" may be returned to the applicant following assessment by the inspector, however it shall be updated as necessary by the applicant/licensee and maintained at the installation.
