TECHNICAL KNOWLEDGE

Kilsaran Concrete is a large and long-established quarrying company with experience of operating waste recovery facilities. The company currently holds one EPA Waste Licence, three Waste Recovery Permits and one Certificate of Registration.

The company currently holds an EPA Waste Licence (Ref. W0296-01) in respect of inert soil and stone recovery at its quarry at Tullykane, Kilmessan, Co. Meath. This licence provides for the recovery of soil and stone through placement on land and its beneficial use in the backfilling and restoration of the former quarry workings.

The Waste Facility Permits currently held by the company are for

- construction and demolition waste recovery facilities at Ballinascorney Quarry, South County (i) Dublin (WFP-DS-11-0009-04)
- (ii) construction and demolition waste recovery facilities at Rathcore Quarry, County Meath (WFP-MH-10-0015-01) and
- (iii) inert soil and stone waste recovery facilities at Halverstown Pit, Kilcullen, Co. Kildare (WFP-KE-0016-085-01).

The Certificate of Registration is held in respect of construction and demolition waste recovery activities at Gallstown Quarry, County Louth (COR-LH-13-0004-01).

The Facility Manager at the existing waste recovery facility at Halverstown is WESLEY HENDY who is also the Kilsaran site manager for the adjoining concrete production plant and the nearby sand and gravel pit at Ballysaxhills. Wesley previously managed one of Kilsaran's readymix concrete plants in Dublin and, prior to that, had been site Foreman at Hanlon Concrete, Robertstown for over 10 years.

The deputy site manager at Halverstown AND COEN. He previously served as dry products facility manager at Kilsaran Brownstown for 8 years. Prior to that he was manager of extractive activities at Brownstown, with 4 years experience in a technical capacity at another of Kilsaran's multi manufacturing / extractive facilities in Co. Offaly.

Wesley and David have the following roles and responsibilities in respect of day-to-day management and operation of the existing permitted waste recovery facility at the application site:

- Liaison with Regulatory Authorities;
- Ensuring Compliance with Waste Licence Conditions;
- Management of Staff (including consultants), Contractors, Plant and Human Resources
- Waste classification and testing;
- Establishment and monitoring of waste handling and acceptance procedures;
- **Environmental monitoring**

In the event that the Agency approves this Waste Licence application, it is envisaged that Wesley and David will continue in their roles as Facility Manager and Deputy Facility Manager (respectively) for the expanded waste recovery operation. A copy of the existing / future site management structure at the recovery facility is attached.

It is envisaged that additional technical / compliance support will be provided to the site-based team by FERGUS GALLAGHER. Fergus is a Chartered Minerals Surveyor and has been the Kilsaran Group Planning and Environmental Manager for over 23 years. If required, additional technical support can also be provided by independent external environmental consultants.


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HALVERSTOWN WASTE RECOVERY FACILITY
