

## EIA Screening Determination

In accordance with Section 83(2A) of the EPA Act 1992, as amended, the Agency has, as part of its consideration of the Industrial Emissions licence application review referenced below, determined whether the application should be made subject to an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) as respects the matters that come within the functions of the Agency. ### EIA Screening Determination:


Following the consideration of further information received from the applicant, the Agency has revised its EIA screening determination of 28/09/2017, as follows:

EIA, as respects the matters that come within the functions of the Agency, is not required for the activity to which the above licence application relates.

Having considered the information provided by the applicant, the nature, size and location of the activity it has been determined that while the activity/changes to the activity are of the following type of project in Schedule 5, Part 2 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 as amended:

*11.(b) Installations for the disposal of waste with an annual intake greater than 25,000 tonnes not included in Part 1 of this Schedule.*

It is noted that there is no proposed change to the overall waste quantity to be accepted at the installation. The activity is unlikely to give rise to significant effects on the environment by virtue of its nature, size and location.
