

APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR A WASTE LICENCE

DUBLIN CITY COUNCIL

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with the provisions of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2011 and Articles 5 and 6 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004 (S.I. No. 395 of 2004) that Dublin City Council, Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8 intends to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Johnstown Castle Estate, County Wexford, for a Waste Licence for the North City Operations Depot.

The Waste Licence application is for the carrying out of municipal waste handling and management activities including waste compaction area with associated ramps and waste collection area with associated ramps, at the new North City Operations Depot in accordance with the requirements of Dublin City Council's daily operations.

The North City Operations Depot is located in the townlands of Balcurris and Ballymun at St. Margaret's Road, Ballymun, Dublin 8 (Grid Reference E314985, N240872).

The classes of activity concerned are specified in the Third and Fourth Schedules of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2011, as follows:

The principal activity to be carried out on the site is:

Class D15 (3rd Schedule): Storage pending any of the operations numbered D1 to D14 (excluding temporary storage (being preliminary storage according to the definition of 'collection' in section 5(1)), pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced).

The facility is also covered under the following classes of activity:

Class D13 (3rd Schedule): Blending or mixing prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D12 (if there is no other D code appropriate, this can include preliminary operations prior to disposal including pre-processing such as, amongst others, sorting, crushing, compacting, pelletising, drying, shredding, conditioning or separating prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D12).

Class D14 (3rd Schedule): Repackaging prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D13.

Class R12 (4th Schedule): Exchange of waste for submission to any of the operations numbered R 1 to R 11 (if there is no other R code appropriate, this can include preliminary operations prior to recovery including pre-processing such as, amongst others, dismantling, sorting, crushing, compacting, pelletising, drying, shredding, conditioning, repackaging, separating, blending or mixing prior to submission to any of the operations numbered R1 to R11).

Class R13 (4th Schedule): Storage of waste pending any of the operations numbered R1 to R12 (excluding temporary storage (being preliminary storage according to the definition of 'collection' in section 5(1)), pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced).

A copy of the Waste Licence Application, and such further information relating to the effects on the environment of emissions from the activity which may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the Application, will, as soon as is practicable after receipt by the Agency, be available for inspection on the Agency's website or for inspection or purchase, at EPA Headquarters, Johnstown Castle Estate, County Wexford.
