

APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR A WASTE LICENCE

DUBLIN CITY COUNCIL

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with the provisions of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2011 and Articles 5 and 6 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004 (S.I. No. 395 of 2004) that Dublin City Council, Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8 intends to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Johnstown Castle Estate, County Wexford, for a Waste Licence for the Ballymun Recycling Centre.

The Waste Licence application is for the operation of a new public civic amenity facility for the collection, recycling and transfer of domestic waste. The new public civic amenity facility will be developed as part of the new North City Operations Depot on behalf of Dublin City Council.

The Ballymun Recycling Centre is located in the townland of Balcurris at St. Margaret's Road, Ballymun, Dublin 8 (Grid Reference E314672, N240884).

The classes of activity concerned are specified in the Third and Fourth Schedules of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2011, as follows:

The principal activity to be carried out on the site is:

Class R13 (4th Schedule): Storage of waste pending any of the operations numbered R1 to R12 (excluding temporary storage (being preliminary storage according to the definition of 'collection' in section 5(1)), pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced).

The facility is also covered under the following classes of activity:

Class D13 (3rd Schedule): Blending or mixing prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D12 (if there is not other D code appropriate, this can include preliminary operations prior to disposal including pre-processing such as, amongst others, sorting, crushing, compacting, pelletising, drying, shredding, conditioning or separating prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D12).

Class D14 (3rd Schedule): Repackaging prior to submission to any of the operations numbered D1 to D13.

Class D15 (3rd Schedule): Storage pending any of the operations numbered D1 to D14 (excluding temporary storage (being preliminary storage according to the definition of 'collection' in section 5(1)), pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced).

Class R03 (4th Schedule): Recycling/reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological transformation processes), which includes gasification and pyrolysis using the components as chemicals.

Class R04 (4th Schedule): Recycling/reclamation of metals and metal compounds.

Class R05 (4th Schedule): Recycling/reclamation of other inorganic materials, which includes soil cleaning resulting in recovery of the soil and recycling of inorganic construction materials.

Class R12 (4th Schedule): Exchange of waste for submission to any of the operations numbered R 1 to R 11 (if there is no other R code appropriate, this can include preliminary operations prior to recovery including pre-processing such as, amongst others, dismantling, sorting, crushing, compacting, pelletising, drying, shredding, conditioning, repackaging, separating, blending or mixing prior to submission to any of the operations numbered R1 to R11).

A copy of the Waste Licence Application, and such further information relating to the effects on the environment of emissions from the activity which may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the Application, will, as soon as is practicable after receipt by the Agency, be available for inspection on the Agency's website or for inspection or purchase, at EPA Headquarters, Johnstown Castle Estate, County Wexford.
