

Attachment-8-2-1-Waste Hierarchy

Operational activities within the Ballymun Recycling Centre will involve the acceptance and pre-treatment of waste from the public prior to removal off-site for recovery and disposal.

As such, there will be no waste materials generated at the facility which will require management in accordance with Section 21A of the *Waste Management Act 1996*, as amended. A small quantity of waste materials will be generated in the facility office from operations and welfare activities. Waste generated in the office will be segregated and deposited in the waste containers at the facility for removal off-site.

Attachment-4-3-7-1 (Waste Hierarchy Consideration) sets out the procedures in place to ensure that waste material received at the facility, and subsequently transferred off-site for recovery or disposal, is managed in accordance with the provisions of the waste hierarchy as set out in the EU Waste Framework Directive (Directive 2008/98/EC).
