

Attachment 2-5-1 Convictions & Remedial Actions

1.1 Conviction

On the 26th of March 2018, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) prosecuted Dublin Waste to Energy Limited at Dublin Metropolitan Court for breaches of its Industrial Emissions Licence (Reg. No. W0232-01).

The company pleaded guilty to the following:

On dates from the 1st day of June 2017 to the 2nd day of June 2017 (both dates inclusive)

Failing to ensure, in the event of an incident occurring on the facility, that your facility manager notified the Agency as soon as practicable and in any case not later than 10.00 a.m. the following working day after the occurrence of any incident; and/or

Failing to notify the Agency, in a format as may be specified by the Agency, without delay after the occurrence of any breach of one or more of the conditions attached to the said Licence.

On hearing details of the offence, Judge F. Brennan convicted the company on the above charge and imposed a fine of €1,000. He applied the Probation Act to two other charges. He also awarded costs of €14,133 to the EPA.

1.2 Remedial Action

DWtE updated their Incident Reporting procedure so that the EPA is notified as soon as practicable of an incident occurring on site and in a format acceptable to the EPA.
