

## APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR A REVIEW OF A LICENCE

Dublin Waste to Energy Limited is applying to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for a review of its Industrial Emissions Licence (Reg. No. W0232-01). The classes of Industrial Emissions Directive Activity are:

Class 11.1. The recovery or disposal of waste in a facility, within the meaning of the Act of 1996, which facility is connected or associated with another activity specified in this Schedule in respect of which a licence or revised licence under Part IV is in force or in respect of which a licence under the said Part is or will be required and

Class 11.3 (a). Disposal or recovery of waste in waste incineration plants or in waste co-incineration plants for non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 3 tonnes per hour.

The site is located in the townland of Ringsend at Pigeon House Road, Poolbeg Peninsula, Dublin 4, Co. Dublin (National Grid Reference E319921, N233565).

This application principally relates to a proposal to increase the amount of waste that Dublin Waste to Energy Limited can accept by 15%.
