Re: NOTIFICATION OF WASTE LICENCE APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY BY PACKAGING LAUNDRY LIMITED FOR THE OPERATION OF A WASTE FACILITY AT OLD COURT BUSINESS PARK, BOGHALL ROAD, BRAY, CO. WICKLOW (NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE: 325594, 216897)

Dear Sir/Madam,

In accordance with Article 9 (1) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004, as amended, Packaging Laundry Limited, Oldcourt Business Park, Boghall Road, Bray, County Wicklow hereby give written notice of the following application for a Waste Licence Application to the Environmental Protection Agency.

APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR A WASTE LICENCE

Packaging Laundry give notice that a waste licence is being sought for the continued operation of waste facility on lands associated with Unit 4C, Oldcourt Business Park, Boghall Road, Bray.

The primary objective of this Licence Application is to expand the activities of the facility, which currently operates under a waste facility permit issued by Wicklow County Council on 30th May 2018 (Waste Facility Permit Reg. No. WFP-WW-18-0043-01). Current site activity includes the re-conditioning/refurbishment of empty industrial packaging (notably IBCs). The permit allows collection of metal and plastic packaging material defined under List of Waste Codes 15 01 02 and 15 01 04.

The application seeks to expand activity at the facility to include for the reception, storage and recovery of metal, composite, paper, cardboard, wooden and plastic packaging materials. The company plans to expand services so that



limited packaging defined under List of Waste Code 15 01 10* can be accepted and refurbished. To facilitate this activity, Packaging Laundry has been advised by the Environmental Protection Agency through the Article 11 process that a waste licence is required. The total tonnage sought is 1,650 tonnes per annum.

The principal activity is Class R 4 of the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Act 1996 (as amended), namely the recycling/reclamation of metals and metal compounds.

Other activities include;

- Class R 3 of the Fourth Schedule (Recycling/reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological transformation processes), which includes gasification and pyrolysis using the components as chemicals)
- Class R 5 of the Fourth Schedule (Recycling/reclamation of other inorganic materials, which includes soil cleaning resulting in recovery of the soil and recycling of inorganic construction materials)
- Class R 12 of the Fourth Schedule (Exchange of waste for submission to any of the operations numbered R 1 to R 11 (if there is no other R code appropriate, this can include preliminary operations prior to recovery including pre-processing such as, amongst others, dismantling, sorting, crushing, compacting, pelletising, drying, shredding, conditioning, repackaging, separating, blending or mixing prior to submission to any of the operations numbered R1 to R11))
- Class R 13 of the Fourth Schedule (Storage of waste pending any of the operations numbered R 1 to R 12 (excluding temporary storage (being preliminary storage according to the definition of 'collection' in section 5(1)), pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced)).

A copy of the application for a Waste Licence, various reports and such further information relating to the application as may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application, will, as soon as practicable after receipt by the Agency, be available for inspection on the Agency's website or inspected at, or obtained from the headquarters of the Agency.

The company has placed a notice in the newspaper (Wicklow Voice, published 12th July 2019) and a site notice will be erected indicating the lodgement of a Waste Licence Application.
