The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has granted Galway City Council (GCC) a waste licence (W0013-01) which covers the restoration of the landfill at Carrowbrowne, acceptance of waste to the Civic Waste facility and the development of composting operations at the facility.

As discussed during recent site visits Galway City Council intend to request expression of interest from the private market in Q4 of 2018 for use of the facility in line with current licence conditions (excluding the landfill and ancillaries). It is the intention that should there be an acceptable approach, Galway city Council will commence further consultation with the EPA and other relevant departments with the view of re-commencing operations in Q1 2019.

Any potential operations will be designed and constructed by a specialised team to ensure all works and operations are completed to a satisfactory requirement within the bounds of the existing waste licence.
