
EIA Screening Determination:

EIA, as respects the matters that come within the functions of the Agency, is required for the activity to which the above licence application relates due to the following reasons:

Having considered the information provided by the applicant, it has been determined that the changes to the activity constitute a project to which the EIA Directive applies and is likely to give rise to significant effects on the environment by virtue of its nature, size and location.

The changes to the activity exceed the following threshold in Schedule 5 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 as amended:
