Notification in accordance with Regulation 11(2)(b) of the EPA (IE) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, in respect of a licence review from Clondrisse Pig Farm Limited for an installation located at Clondrisse Pig Farm Limited (Joristown Upper), Joristown Upper, Killucan, Westmeath, N91 HK27

Dear Sir,

I refer to the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), dated November 2011, submitted as part of your licence review which was received on 11 June 2018.

In accordance with the above referenced legislation, the EPA has assessed the information submitted and has determined that the EIS submitted does not adequately identify, describe and assess the direct and indirect effects of the development on the environment.

Directive 2014/52/EU on the assessment of the effects of certain public and private projects on the environment (EIA Directive) came into effect on 16 May 2017. Having regard to the above, the Agency are now seeking further information on your application and associated EIS and you are required to update the EIS in accordance with the requirements of Directive 2014/52/EU amending Directive 2011/92/EU on the assessment of the effects of certain public and private projects on the environment (2014 EIA Directive).

The Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) should be submitted to the Agency not later than 4 months of the date of this notice, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application in a timely manner.

In addition to the above please also provide an updated non-technical summary to reflect the information provided in your reply.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the Agency is to decide the proposed determination cannot commence until this notice has been complied with.
