Dear Madam,

I refer to your application which was received by the EPA on 02 June 2018.

I am directed to refer to your application for a waste licence. The application refers to a Court Order requiring Remediation in accordance with Condition 12 of planning permission PL09.205039. It appears that Condition requires a plan approved by the planning authority. The licence application does not demonstrate that such approval has been obtained. Accordingly, the Agency will treat your application as an application not governed by the Court Order and Condition 12.

Accordingly, you should as required by Section 42(1B)(a) of the Waste Management Act 1996 as amended, submit confirmation in writing from a planning authority or An Bord Pleanála, as the case may be, that an application for permission comprising or for the purposes of the activity to which the application for a licence relates, is currently under consideration by the planning authority concerned or An Bord Pleanála, along with the EIA Report already submitted.

If you wish to submit in lieu a letter from the planning authority confirming the proposed activity is approved in accordance with Condition 12 of the permission, the Agency will treat the permission submitted by you as "a copy of a grant of permission comprising or for the purposes of the activity to which the application for the licence relates that was issued by the planning authority concerned or An Bord Pleanála" for the purposes of Section 42(1B)(b) of the 1996 Act.

The proposal as currently submitted does not meet either requirement as it is not clear whether the proposed activity complies with the requirements of Condition 12 or is for a substantively different development.

Please note that, in the absence of such confirmation, the Agency is precluded by Section 42(1C) of the Act from further considering your application.
