**RE: Waste Licence W0234-02 for the Facility at Six Cross Roads, Kilbarry, Waterford.
Request for Extension of Duration under Section 49 of the
Waste Management Act 1996 - 2016**

A Chara,

I refer to the above licence, which was granted 6th February 2014, and to the extension of duration dated 1st February 2017, extending the duration of the licence until 6th February 2020.

The main licensed activity is anaerobic digestion, and this has not yet commenced. The site has been unused since the Compost Centre ceased operations.

Initially the redevelopment of the site was held up due to legal issues, which were resolved and a lease was to be signed with FLI International Ltd in 2017. However, FLI International Ltd went into liquidation in October 2017 and the lease could not be completed.

Waterford City and County Council then decided to put the site on the market. An offer was made by Rathdrinagh Land Ltd, which was accepted and contracts for the sale were signed.

Waterford City and County Council would therefore request that the current licence be extended for 6 months to allow the completion of the contract and the transfer of the current licence to Rathdrinagh Land Ltd.
