<b>RE:</b>	Clerical Amendment to Industrial Emissions Licence Register Number: W0261-02, held by Starrus Eco Holdings Limited for an installation located at Cappagh Road, Cappogue, Finglas, Dublin 11.

A clerical amendment is required to correct clerical errors noted in Technical Amendment A issued on 22 January 2020 to allow for the correct interpretation of the licence requirements.

This memo recommends that the change may be accommodated by a Clerical Amendment, in accordance with Section 96(1)(a) of Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992 as amended.

### 1. Background

Starrus Eco Holdings Limited was granted a revised licence, Reg. No. W0261-02 on 11 February 2015 for an installation located at Cappagh Road, Cappogue, Finglas, Dublin 11. The licensee was granted a Technical Amendment A on 22 January 2020 amending the hours of operation, waste acceptance and dispatch at the installation to take account of a planning permission.

### 2. Clerical Amendment

On 24 February 2020, the Agency initiated a Clerical Amendment of IE Licence Reg. No. W0261-02, in order to correct the date in Condition 3.24.2 so that it accurately reflects the planning permission granted to the Licensee. This was envisaged by the Inspector as outlined in the Memo dated 21 January 2020 which accompanies the recommended Technical Amendment. Having reviewed the Notification of Grant of Planning Permission it is proposed to amend the date in Condition 3.24.2 to reflect the 3 year duration of the extended hours to 3 December 2022. The amendment also clarifies that the 'extension' referred to in the Technical Amendment relates to the Planning Permission for the installation.

### 3. Recommendation

I recommend that the licence amendment be approved as set out in the attached recommended Clerical Amendment B.
