
### EIA Screening Preliminary Examination:

EIA, as respects the matters that come within the functions of the Agency, is not required for the activity to which the above licence application relates.

The activity is below the specified threshold of project type 11(b) in Part 2 of Schedule 5 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 as amended and having considered the information provided by the applicant, it has been determined that the activity is not likely to give rise to significant effects on the environment by virtue of its nature, size and location.

This determination has been made having regard to the following

- The limited nature and scale of the activity.
- The absence of any significant environmental sensitivity in the vicinity and the absence of any likely significant effect on any sensitive location.
- With regard to emissions, the activities are not likely to result in significant effects on the environment when considered in relation to the criteria as set out in Annex III of the EIA Directive.
