Notification in accordance with 87(1E)(c) of the EPA Act 1992, as amended, in respect of a licence application from Doon Farm Enterprises Limited for an installation located at Doon Farm Enterprises Limited, Doon, Araglin, Kilworth, County Tipperary.

Dear Sir or Madam,

I refer to our previous notification to you requesting comments in relation to the licence application from Doon Farm Enterprises Limited for an installation located at Doon, Araglin, Kilworth, Co. Tipperary, Register No. P1024-02.

I also refer to your response of the 27 April 2017 which has been noted.

In accordance with 87(1E)(c) of the EPA Act 1992, as amended, you are asked to have regard to the following:

- The licence application documentation specifies the capacity of the activity at the installation to be 400 dry sows, 80 gilts, 100 farrowing sows, 3,000 weaners and 4,000 fatteners. Having regard to the definition of a sow under the Danish ECJ judgement case C-585/10 and to Class 6.2 of the First Schedule of the EPA Act, this amounts to 500 sows and 4,000 production pigs.
- A copy of the application submitted by the applicant and associated correspondence are available for inspection by you on the Agency's website <a href="https://www.epa.ie">www.epa.ie</a>.

You are requested to respond to the Agency within <u>2 weeks of receipt of this notice</u> and furnish any observations your authority has in relation to the licence application, and specifically to the following items:

- 1. State whether the activity to which the licence application relates is permitted by the planning permissions granted for the site, and confirm if the planning permissions granted allow for the animal numbers specified above.
- 2. Where planning permissions do not allow for the animal numbers specified above, where possible, specify the animal numbers by category permitted by the planning permissions granted for the site.

It would be much appreciated that all documentation is submitted in <u>electronic PDF format</u> to <u>licensing@epa.ie</u> in order to facilitate the publishing of information to the Agency's website.

Please note that all further information received on this licence application will be made available on the Agency's website.

The application is being processed by the Agency. All information submitted will be considered as part of the licence application assessment process. You will be notified of the proposed determination in due course.
