Section 2.8 The 'Recommendation' applies to condition *3.13* Delete the'?' from bullet point (i) of the Recommendation.

The Directors approved the recommendations of the Technical Committee with the following amendments:

Conditions

- **3.1(d)** Amend the condition as follows: 'Install a low permeability landfill cap, minimum 1m, with 1mm thick low permeability geomembrane, *having or equivalent, to achieve* a hydraulic conductivity of less than or equal to 1×10^{-9} m/s.'
- **3.1(g)** Insert a new condition 3.1 g) to read as follows: *'Install at least one groundwater monitoring borehole downgradient of the landfill.'*
- **3.5(e)** Amend the condition as follows: 'monitoring (sample, analyse and characterise) on a biannual basis of groundwater from at least three *one* groundwater monitoring boreholes, two of which shall be downgradient of the closed landfill; and'

Recommended Decision

Following discussion, the Directors approved the recommendation to grant a Certificate of Authorisation, as modified, to Limerick City and County Council for the closed landfill at Knocknacarriga, Cappamore, County Limerick, Register No H0277-01, subject to the conditions as set out in the authorisation.
