## Re: <u>Notice in accordance with Regulation 18(3)(b) of the Waste Water</u> Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007, as amended.

Dear Sir or Madam

I refer to your application for a waste water discharge licence relating to agglomeration named Youghal, Reg. No. D0139-02.

Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Regulation 16 of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations 2007, as amended.

You are therefore required, in accordance with Regulation 18(3)(b) of the Regulations, to take steps to supply the information detailed below:

## **REGULATION 16 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS**

- Provide an up to date impact assessment of existing or proposed waste water discharges to the receiving environment (including a modelling report). Apply a 2D depth-averaged hydrodynamic flow model and a dispersion model to simulate tidal circulations, to provide flow patterns and to track particles, or equivalent. Include details of the receiving environment, protected areas and details of the measures required to achieve the relevant environmental objectives and standards established for the receiving waters and the current River Basin District Management Plan priorities.
- Submit a Natura Impact Statement, as defined in Regulation 2(1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended.

You are furthermore advised to refer to the EPA's guidance 'Note on Appropriate Assessments for the purposes of the Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations, 2007 (S.I.
