Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, in respect of a licence application from Roadstone Limited for a facility located at Midleton Quarry, Castleredmond, Midleton, Cork, D24PKK2

Dear Sir,

I refer to the application for a licence received by the EPA on 18 December 2019.

Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with the above mentioned legislation. You are therefore requested, in accordance with the regulations, to supply the information detailed below.

ARTICLE 12 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

In relation to the proposed drainage plan at the hardstanding area (Drawing ref: CP17028WL0008) please provide a revised drawing including the following:

- a labelled monitoring point at the discharge of the fuel/oil interceptor
- coordinates of this monitoring point (Irish grid reference, 6-digit easting and 6-digit northing)

ARTICLE 13 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

The following information is required in order to meet statutory requirements for information to be contained within an EIAR as set out in in Article 94 and Schedule 6 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended by S.I. No. 296 of 2018) and Directive 2014/52/EU amending Directive 2011/92/EU (EIA Directive):

- A non-technical summary of the information referred to in points (a) to (d) of Article 5(1) of Directive 2014/52/EU amending Directive 2011/92/EU (EIA Directive)
- A reference list detailing the sources used for the descriptions and assessments included in the report

A screening for Appropriate Assessment was undertaken on 11 June 2020 and the Agency

determined that an Appropriate Assessment of the proposed activity is required.

You are thereby required to submit a Natura Impact Statement, as defined in Regulation 2(1)

of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended.

You are furthermore advised to refer to the document 'Appropriate Assessment of Plans and

Projects in Ireland – Guidance for Planning Authorities', issued in 2009 by the Department of

the Environment, Heritage and Local Government, and revised in 2010. This document is

In addition to the above, please also provide an updated non-technical summary

(Application Form, and EIS where applicable) to reflect the information provided in your

reply, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.

annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are

submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which
