Drogheda Landfill Site Waste Licence Review

In accordance with article 9 of the Waste Management (licensing) Regulations 2004 as amended, we hereby wish to notify the planning department, that Louth County are undertaking a review of the waste licence (Ref No W0033-01) for the Drogheda Landfill Site, Collon Road, Mell Drogheda Co Louth. The review is required to change the boundary of the landfill to take in an additional 22 hectares of land which is to be capped and restored in accordance with Licence Conditions.

The classes of activity concerned are:

Owner D 15 Storage pending any of the operations numbered D 1 to D 14 (excluding temporary storage (being preliminary storage according to the definition of collection in section 5(1)), pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced).

R 3 Recycling/reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological transformation processes), which includes gasification and pyrolysis using the components as chemicals

R 4 Recycling/reclamation of metals and metal compounds

R 5 Recycling/reclamation of other inorganic materials, which includes soil cleaning resulting in recovery of the soil and recycling of inorganic construction materials

R 10 Land treatment resulting in benefit to agriculture or ecological improvement

R 11 Use of waste obtained from any of the operations numbered R 1 to R 10

R 13 Storage of waste pending any of the operations numbered R 1 to R 12 (excluding temporary storage (being preliminary storage according to the definition of 'collection' in section 5(1)), pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced)".

The Application for the review of the Waste Licence and such further information relating to the application as may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application will, as soon as is practicable after receipt by the Agency, be inspected on the Agency's website or inspected at or obtained from the headquarters of the Environmental Protection Agency and at the Principal Offices of Louth County Council, County, County Hall, Millennium Centre, Dundalk, Co Louth normal working hours (Monday to Friday, excluding public holidays).
