Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, in respect of a licence application from Glv Bay Lane Limited for a facility located at GLV Bay Lane Limited, Bay Lane Quarry, Bay Lane, St. Margaret's, Dublin, D15 P924

Dear Sir or Madam,

I refer to the application for a licence received by the EPA on 05 April 2019.

Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with the above mentioned legislation. You are therefore requested, in accordance with the regulations, to supply the information detailed below.

ARTICLE 12 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. With regards to the exploration boreholes referred to in the application, please provide the following:
 - (a) Provide coordinates and a map showing the location of the six exploration wells (coordinates should be expressed as six-digit easting and northing GPS Irish National Grid references);
 - (b) Provide any groundwater monitoring results from the six exploration wells;
 - (c) State the direction of the groundwater flow and which of the six exploration wells can or will be used to represent the up-gradient and down gradient water quality.

A screening for Appropriate Assessment was undertaken on 23 September 2020 and the Agency determined that an Appropriate Assessment of the proposed activity is required.

You are thereby required to submit a Natura Impact Statement, as defined in Regulation 2(1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended.

It is noted that a Natura Impact Statement has been already submitted with the application

You are furthermore advised to refer to the document '*Appropriate Assessment of Plans and Projects in Ireland – Guidance for Planning Authorities*', issued in 2009 by the Department of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government, and revised in 2010.
