Dear Sir,

I refer to documentation received by the EPA on 31st July 2020 and to any previous documentation received in relation to a licence application.

I advise that the information received has been assessed and your application is now deemed to be in compliance with acknowledgement in relation Article 12 and Article 13 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations as of 31st July 2020.

I am to advise you that any person may make a submission to the EPA, in writing, in respect of the application, pursuant to Article 15 of the Regulations, which provides as follows:

Submissions to the Agency regarding applications.

15. For the purpose of Section 40(2)(b) of the Acts, a person may make a written submission to the Agency in relation to -

- (i) an application, and
- (ii) such plans, documents and other information and particulars, including an environmental impact assessment report, as are submitted by the applicant in accordance with articles 12, 13, 14 and 16,

and the Agency shall not give notice of a proposed decision under section 42(2) of the Acts before the expiry of a period of 30 days following the date of a relevant –

- (a) acknowledgement in accordance with Article 14(2)(a), or

- (b) notice in accordance with Article 16(2)(a), or
 - (c) acknowledgement in accordance with Article 16(4),
- whichever such date is the later.

The Agency will have regard to any submission made in accordance with the Regulations and will write, in due course, to each person who makes such a submission, to advise them of the Agency's proposed decision on the application.

Any person may make such a submission on this application, in writing, via the EPA's website at www.epa.ie.
