Dear Director,

As a person who is qualified, trained and experienced to the standard set out in section 2.3 of *Code of Practice: Environmental Risk Assessment for Unregulated Waste Disposal Sites* (EPA, 2007), it is my opinion that the risk assessment carried out by Clare County Council on the closed landfill at **Dysert, Kilrush** is adequate and complete.

The risk assessment complies with all of the requirements of the *Code of Practice*. The local authority through its contractor O'Callaghan Moran & Associates, in carrying out the risk assessment, has followed and completed the steps set out in the *Code of Practice* and associated guidance (Matrix 1 and Matrix 2 – as published).

The following items:

- - the risk assessment,
- - the findings and conclusions of the risk assessment,
- - the remedial measures proposed
- - the monitoring proposed to be carried out to demonstrate the effectiveness of the remedial measures,


are, in my opinion, appropriate and adequate to:-

- identify the instances and risks of environmental pollution arising from the closed landfill to which this application refers,
- proportionately address any and all such instances and risks of environmental pollution,
- ensure that any future instances of environmental pollution will be detected in a timely manner.
