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1 Conformance to the Principles of the Waste Hierarchy

Currently the sharps bins in question are collected and dispatched to a third part waste treatment facility. The Proposed waste activity will involve the redirection of the sharps bins themselves from the aforementioned recovery process and the direct reuse of these sharps bins in the course of the applicants business. Thus, the Proposed Waste Activity results in the reuse of a material previously deemed a waste. All Sharps Waste arriving on-site will be temporarily stored on-site before being dispatched to a third-party Waste Facility for recovery in adherence with the principles of the Waste Hierarchy.
