Notice in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 as amended, in respect of a licence application from Healthbeacon Limited for a facility located at Healthbeacon Limited, Unit 18, Naas Road Business Park, Muirfield Drive, Naas Road, Dublin 12, Dublin, D12 PF63

Dear Sir,

I refer to your application for a licence received by the EPA on 17 November 2020.

I advise that in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 as amended (hereafter referred to as “the Regulations”), the information required under the regulations in support of the application must be updated to reflect compliance with Articles 6 and 7 of the Regulations as follows:

1. The National Grid reference provided in the newspaper notice, for the location of the facility, appears to be incorrect. The National Grid reference for the facility should be given in the Irish National Grid format of 6 digits Easting and 6 digits Northing.
2. The classes of activity listed in the site notice and newspaper notice shall be updated on foot of the notice issued under Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Regulations on 18/03/2021. In the case of two or more activities being proposed the principal activity should be identified.
3. The newspaper notice provided with the application refers to a list of waste code 18 01 01 which is not proposed for acceptance in the application. The newspaper notice should be updated to include all wastes proposed for acceptance at the facility.

The EPA therefore requires you to republish the newspaper and site notices referring to the [‘Newspaper notices - guidance for applicants’](#) and [‘Site Notices - Guidance for applicants’](#) documents on the EPA website. The site notice should be erected for a period of two months.

Please submit the following evidence that you have complied with the regulations:

1. An extract of the revised notice published in the newspaper, in PDF format;
2. An extract of the revised site notice erected on site;
3. Photographic evidence of the revised site notice erected on site.

The requested information should be submitted to the EPA within **4 calendar weeks** of the date of this notice in order to allow the EPA to process and determine your application.
