**RE: APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE  
REVIEW OF A LICENCE**

Dear Mr. Keegan,

I wish to inform you that in accordance with the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992 as amended, that Dublin Waste to Energy Limited, intends to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) for a review of an Industrial Emissions (Licence (Reg. No. W0232-01) (Licence Review). The site is located within the townlands of Ringsend, at Pigeon House Road, Poolbeg Peninsula, Dublin 4, (National Grid Reference E319934, N233597).

The applicable classes of Industrial Emissions Directive Activity in accordance with the First Schedule to the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992, as amended, is as follows

- Class 11.1 The recovery or disposal of waste in a facility, within the meaning of the Act of 1996, which facility is connected or associated with another activity specified in this Schedule in respect of which a licence or revised licence under Part IV is in force or in respect of which a licence under the said Part is or will be required
- Class 11.3 (a) Disposal or recovery of waste in waste incinerations plants or in waste co-incinerations plants for non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 3 tonnes per hour.

An Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) and Appropriate Assessment will be submitted to the Agency and have previously been submitted to An Bord Pleanála as part of a planning permission application (Planning Reference PL29S.309812).

The EIAR submitted to the Agency in accordance with section 83(2A)(d) of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992, any information provided to the Agency under paragraph (e) or (f)(ii)(II) of section 83(2A) of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992, any opinion issued by the Agency under section 83(2A)(de) of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992 on the scope of the EIAR, and any further information, including reports and advice, relating to the environmental impact assessment as may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application, shall each be made available on the Agency's website and at the headquarters of the Agency.

Submissions may be made in writing to the Agency in relation to the likely effects on the environment of the proposed activity within the period specified by the Agency on its website under Regulation 4(2)(c). In accordance with section 87(2) of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992, a proposed determination shall be published by the Agency on its website.

A copy of the application for the Licence Review may be inspected on the Agency's website or inspected at or obtained from the headquarters of the Agency as soon as is practicable after the receipt by the Agency of the application for the Licence Review.
