As a person who is qualified, trained and experienced to the standard set out in Section 2.3 of *Code of Practice: Environmental Risk Assessment for Unregulated Waste Disposal* (EPA, 2007), it is my opinion that the risk assessment carried out by others on behalf of **Mayo County Council** in relation to a closed landfill at **Claremorris Co. Mayo** is adequate and complete. The risk assessment complies with all of the requirements of the *Code of Practice*. The local authority or its agent/contractor, in carrying out the risk assessment, has followed and completed the steps set out in the *Code of Practice* and associated guidance (Matrix 1 and Matrix 2 – as published).

- identify the instances and risks of environmental pollution arising from the closed landfill to which this application refers,


