'2. Please submit the leachate, groundwater monitoring and landfill gas results, as required in, respectively, Points 4 and 5 of the Agency's Notice issued on 29th January 2021, once monitoring is complete.

Please note that the response made on 26th February to the Agency's Notice issued on 29th January outlined a schedule for leachage groundwater and landfill gas monitoring. Monitoring was scheduled to to be undertaken in May with a related report to be submitted to the EPA in late June following receipt and assessment of laboratory results.

In the interim the prolonged Eevel 5 restrictions, which remain in place, have affected this schedule slightly. It is now proposed to carry out this monitoring in the beginning of June 2021. Galway County Council will endeavour to have this monitoring carried out at the earliest possible opportunity and reported without delay following receipt and assessment of laboratory results. We hope that Covid 19 restrictions do not further interfere with our monitoring schedule.

Item Number 3:

Item No. 3 of the request for information states the following:

- '3. Please submit one drawing showing the following elements interpolated:
 - (I) The extent of the waste body
 - (II) All of the existing and proposed monitoring locations including their reference codes, for Landfill gas, leachate, groundwater and surface water; and
 - (III) The site boundary of the entire site.

Please note that due to distance between the landfill site and a number of the surface water monitoring locations, it is not possible to position all requested information on the same drawing due to scale. Please find attached an amended figure, Figure 11 Revision A. This figure shows the site boundary for the entire site, the extent of the waste body and the position of the 3 groundwater/gas and the 2 leachate/gas monitoring wells on site.

The position of the surface water monitoring locations are shown on Figures 15 to 18 of Volume III of the Certificate of Authorisation Application which contains the report, Further Information Hydrology/Tier 3 GQRA/CSM of Former Tullyvogheen Landfill Report, 2020, already submitted.


