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development consisting of the retention of the following elements: 1.8m high boundary fence and gates around and subdividing the site; provision of additional floor to building (to provide staff facilities) and increase in permitted footprint of building to comprise a 2 storey building of c.246sqm; enlargement of permitted anaerobic digester tank No. 3 to now comprise a tank which is 11.5m high and 26m in diameter; provision of 1 no. wood chip air filter; epositioning of permitted biofilter No. 2 on site adjoining existing biofilter. Permitted development referred to above was granted under Ref. 11/455; An Bord Pleanala Ref. PL24.24050543. Permission is sought for the provision of 2 No. airlock entrances to the front elevation of the existing compositing building.
