Notice for Public Consultation on Appropriate Assessment under Regulation 42 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended

The EPA on 5th February 2021 issued an Appropriate Assessment Screening Determination to Clare County Council for a closed landfill located at Kilrush Landfill, Dysert, Kilrush, County Clare, in the townland of Dysert, regarding an application for a certificate of authorisation, Register Number H0030-01.

The application is for a certificate of authorisation, including remedial measures required, at the above referenced closed landfill. The closed landfill site covers an area of 2.6 hectares. Disposal of waste at the site was carried out from 1981 to 1992. Approximately 33,250 tonnes of waste was deposited at the site. The waste comprises of municipal waste, agriculture waste, industrial waste, commercial waste and construction & demolition (C&D) waste.

The EPA has carried out an Appropriate Assessment Screening and has determined that an Appropriate Assessment is required for the activity.
