Re: Further Notice under the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013, in respect of a licence review from Starrus Eco Holdings Limited for an installation located at Starrus Eco Holdings Limited (Littleton), Ballybeg, Littleton, Tipperary, E41 WP83

Dear Sir/Madam

I refer to the Agency's Reminder Notice dated 22nd October 2021 in accordance with Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013. The initial Notice dated 25th August 2021 requested a revised copy of the Notification to the Planning Authority of the intention to apply to the Agency for a review of the licence. This revised Notification was submitted to the Agency on the 28th August. The Agency also noted

... that an application for planning permission is under consideration at this time. (i) In accordance with section 87(1B)(b) of the Act of 1992 provide, a copy of the final grant of planning permission together with either:


a. a copy of the environmental impact assessment (EIA) report (if not already submitted), and any updates relating to EIA required during the application for planning permission process, or

b. a written confirmation from the planning authority or An Bord Pleanála that an environmental impact assessment was not required by or under the Act of 2000 (if not already submitted).

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within 4 weeks from date of final grant of permission, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.

Tipperary County Council granted planning permission; however this has been appealed to an Bord Pleanála by a third party. The case is due to be decided by 9th November 2021. The Bord's decision will be submitted to the Agency on receipt. The EIAR before the Bord was submitted with the licence review application.
