Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, in respect of a licence application from Noel Lawler Sand & Gravel Limited for a facility located at Portersize, Ballitore, Kildare, R14 P627

Dear Sir,

I refer to the application for a licence received by the EPA on 22 October 2021.

Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with the above-mentioned legislation. You are therefore requested, in accordance with the regulations, to supply the information detailed below.

Article 9(1) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004, as amended requires a notice to be provided to the relevant planning authority regarding an application made to the Agency for a licence. You are therefore requested, to re-submit the letter to the relevant planning authority regarding an application made to the Agency. Please refer to [‘Newspaper notices - guidance for applicants’](#) with regard to the information to be contained in the letter to the relevant planning authority.

Please provide evidence of this notice.

It is noted that an application for planning permission is under consideration at this time.

- (i) In accordance with section 87(1B)(b) of the Act of 1992 provide, a copy of the final grant of planning permission together with either:
 - a. a copy of the environmental impact assessment (EIA) report (if not already submitted), and any updates relating to EIA required during the application for planning permission process, or
 - b. a written confirmation from the planning authority or An Bord Pleanála that an environmental impact assessment was not required by or under the Act of 2000 (if not already submitted).

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within *4 weeks from date of final grant of permission*, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.
