Regulation 10(2)(b)(ii) of the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013 as amended, in respect of a licence review from Rilta Environmental Limited for an installation located at Rilta Environmental, Block 14A1, Grant's Road, Greenogue Business Park, Rathcoole, Dublin

Dear Sir,

I refer to the application for a licence received by the EPA on 31 July 2017.

Having examined the documentation submitted, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with the EPA (Industrial Emissions) (Licensing) Regulations 2013 as amended (hereafter referred to as "the Regulations"). You are therefore requested, in accordance with the regulations, to supply the information detailed below.

1. Provide List of Waste (LoW) Codes for <u>ALL</u> waste types (current and proposed) to be accepted at the installation including all hazardous wastes in accordance with Regulation 9(2)t of the Regulations. As previously requested in notices issued by the Agency on 06/06/2018 and 28/05/2020, provide a description of <u>ALL</u> proposed waste activities by completing the following table (the first row is completed as an example and should be deleted to make way for real information):

It is noted that in Attachment D.2 of the application and Attachment 1 of further information received by the Agency on 30/06/2020 there is an increase in tonnage for a number of hazardous waste types (e.g. Waste Oil, Oil filters, Asbestos, Oil/Sand Mixtures or Mixtures of Oil and Other Material, Wood preservation waste, etc.) compared to what is listed in Attachment E.2.2. of the original application Reg. No. W0185-01. Provide details of the storage facilities to accommodate any extra waste tonnages (for all Wastes in Attachment 1) in accordance with Regulation 9(2)g of the Regulations.
- 3. Provide an update of the waste activities and emissions currently at the installation in accordance with Regulation 9(2)g of the Regulations.
- 4. The Energy Audit Report submitted as part of Attachment G of the application states that gas is utilised at the installation. Provide an update to include gas and any other raw and ancillary materials, substances, preparations, fuels and energy which will be produced or utilised (including quantities) at the installation in accordance with Regulation 9(2)f of the Regulations.

In addition to the above, please also provide an updated non-technical summary (Application Form, and EIS where applicable) to reflect the information provided in your reply, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.

The requested information should be submitted to the Agency within <u>4 weeks</u> of the date of this notice, in order to allow the Agency to process and determine your application.

It should be noted that the eight-week period within which the Agency is to decide the proposed determination will commence on the day on which this notice has been complied with. If you have any further queries please contact licensing@epa.ie.

In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.
