There has been a material change, which could not reasonably have been foreseen when the licence was granted, in relation to the receiving waters, namely, the deterioration of the status of the Funshion and Gradoge rivers from 'moderate' to 'poor'. Planning application is due to be submitted in 2022 for proposed development works associated with the licence. Non-compliance with: Storm water overflows do not comply with the criteria outlined in the DoEHLG "Procedures and Criteria in relation to Storm Water Overflows, 1995". The primary discharge does not comply with the emission limit values in Schedule A: Discharges and Discharge Monitoring.
