Cork. The waste water works consists of a new waste water treatment plant at Shanacloon Townland, 121316E, 076048N; a new Primary Discharge (SW001) and new Storm Water Overflow (SW002) from the WWTP, which discharge into the Sullane River, an upgraded Pumping Station at Ballymakeery Townland, 121295E, 076419N, a Storm Water Overflow (SW003) and Emergency Overflow (SW004) from the Pumping Station which discharge into the Sullane River.
