Dear Sir/Madam,

I refer to the Agency's notice which was issued to Mr. Donal Brady dated 18th December 2014 inviting a submission in relation to the Agency's review of the Industrial Emissions (IE) Licence Register Number P0408-01, and to the Agency's letters of the 10th March 2015, 21st March 2016 and 14th June 2016 and Mr. Donal Brady's letter dated 12th March 2015.

It is noted that in the Agency's letter of 14th June 2016, the Agency stated its intention to proceed to adopt a proposed determination on the licence review of licence reference P0408-01. While this process has been delayed, the Agency now intends to proceed to make a determination.

The Agency outlined the information it required to complete the review in its letter of 18th December 2014; however, given the passage of time the following information is now only required:

1. An updated non-technical summary of the activity and associated emissions;
2. If applicable, provide an updated site boundary map (outlined in red), showing buildings, discharge point and monitoring points;
3. Provide details of management and control of organic fertiliser on-site;
4. Provide a copy of the Record 3 forms relating to 2020 and 2021;
5. Provide a baseline report on an assessment undertaken on accordance with Stages 1 to 3 of the European Commission Guidance concerning baseline reports which can be found at: [Communication from the Commission — European Commission Guidance concerning baseline reports under Article 22\(2\) of Directive 2010/75/EU on industrial emissions \(europa.eu\)](https://ec.europa.eu/eia/infocentre/faq.cfm?id=123)
6. The letter of the 18th December 2014 requested a tabulated table on how the BAT conclusions in the BREF document for the Intensive rearing of Poultry and Pigs (July 2003) would be met; however, now that the Commission Implementing Decision (CID) (EU) 2017/302 establishing best available techniques (BAT) conclusions, under Directive 2010/75/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council, for the intensive rearing of poultry or pigs has been published, the licensee should submit a tabulated report on compliance with the CID BAT conclusions;
7. Undertake a screening for appropriate assessment and state whether the activity, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, is likely to have a significant effect on a European Site(s), in view of the best scientific knowledge and the conservation objectives of the sites(s). Where it cannot be excluded, on the basis of objective information, following screening for appropriate assessment, that the activity, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, will have a significant effect on any European Site provide a Natura Impact Statement as defined in Regulation 2(1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations (S.I. 477 of 2011);
8. Supply information to demonstrate that the licensee or other relevant persons is a fit and proper person, as specified in Section 84(4) of the EPA Act 1992 as amended.

It should be noted that any increases in animal numbers or changes to site infrastructure, from that originally licensed, cannot be accommodated as part of this review. This is set out in *Schedule 1(i) Animal Numbers Housed at the Facility* in Licence Reg No. P0408-01.

Any response/submission you may wish to make to this notification should be submitted via the licence review module on EDEN. You will have an opportunity to object to the proposed determination within four weeks of it being sent to you.
